Nick, our SVDA Youth champ, was one of 17 qualifiers from around the US vying for scholarships and the ADO-paid trip to England.

The field of 17 was pared down to 8 for the finals and Nick made the cut. The 8 finalists drew their places in the finals and Compton faced the defending National Youth champ, Ryan Mahaffey, in round 1.

Nick dispatched Mahaffey to reach the semi-finals. In a close match Nick was defeated by Mike Scarborough to just miss the finals. Scarborough lost in the finals to 13-year-old Ashley Stewart.

**Dr. Darto,**  
I am confused about scoring. Some people tell me to put the score on the inside and totals on the outside. Others tell me to do the opposite—scores on the outside and totals on the inside. Who is right? — **Confused**

**Confused.** Good question, Confused. Again, if we go to the official ADO rules, we find the answer. The rule is, "The scorer shall mark the board so that the scores made are listed in the outer columns of the

scoreboard, and the totals remaining are listed in the two middle columns."

**Dr. Darto,**  
If I am chalking how much information must I give the shooter? — **Chatty Chalker**

**Chatty Chalker.** The chalker/scorer may inform how many points the shooter has scored and/or how much the shooter has left. Others (partner, teammate or spectator) may advise the shooter what to throw at, possible combinations, how about a drink, etc., but not the chalker/scorer.

# Dart Talk

**T**wo thousand five was a good year for the SVDA and 2006 looks even better. We had **Scotty Burnett** going to the Nationals again and **Nick Compton** making his first trip to the Youth Nationals and taking one of the top spots. And, it looks like darts are going to be on the tube even more in 2006.

The **Amateur tournaments** are back! The Amateur and Pro tournaments that used to be at the Biltmore, North Shore have moved to the Circus-Circus, Reno, Nevada.

The two cricket tournaments, Amateur and Open Cricket Singles, will be held March 25 and 26, 2006 at the Circus-Circus - Reno. Amateur status is closely checked. Five thousand dollars (\$5000) in prizes for each tournament plus a \$2500 bonus for 8 dart game in the Finals. Both events are Round Robin Cricket Singles.

The **San Francisco Open** is back! After a hiatus of, well too many years, the SF Open is returning. The dates are September 29, 30, and October 1, 2006 at the Janet Pomeroy Center. The Pomeroy Center is located at 207 Skyline Boulevard near Lake Merced and the San Francisco

Zoo. Details regarding deals with nearby motels for accommodations and, hopefully, a shuttle are being worked.

It looks like the total purse will be \$5,040, though it may be tweaked again before it is finalized. The SF Open will have 9 events (Singles & Doubles 501 and Cricket for both men and women, plus a Friday Blind Draw). The current plan is to leave Saturday night fairly free to afford the players a chance to spend a little time in San Francisco away from playing darts. Our brethren in San Francisco, "The City" for Bay Area-types, are working on a flyer and will begin distributing it as soon as it is complete and sanctioned by the ADO.

On a sad note it looks like the long and successful run of the **Truckee Meadows** tournament is over for the foreseeable future. Tournament directors John and Kathy Boyne have been unable to find a suitable location since the Biltmore at North Shore dropped its sponsorship of dart tournaments. The Boyne's have not given up the search and we are all hoping they are successful in finding a new venue.

SVDA 2006 Youth Shoot will be Saturday, April 1, 2006 at the Brick Oven Pizza. This event is open to those 17 and under.

Your SVDA Board of Directors is again sponsoring four events in 2006 that can lead to entry to regional and national events but are, more importantly, just good competitive fun. These four events, 3 are 501 and one is cricket, are labeled as ADO

qualifiers but are merely round robin shoots. So, you play a lot of darts and have a lot of fun. All of the events are at the Brick Oven Pizza. The 2006 dates are:

We would have liked to get the word out about Nick's accomplishment in the summer issue of The Shaft when it would have been more timely but our deadline would not permit it. Again, congratulations to Nick Compton, our SVDA 2006 Youth champ and one of the top 4 Youth Darters in the United States.

**Fox Sports Bay Area** (Channel 419 on Dish) has been showing Las Vegas Desert Classic III and IV tournaments. Typically, FSBA shows a round of preliminaries, fox example on a Saturday or Sunday and repeats the show on Tuesday. But times do change. Fox Sport just finished the Desert Classic IV with **Phil Taylor's** convincing win over Wayne Mardle in the Las Vegas Desert Classic IV finals. Taylor averaged over 106 points in every three dart turn. In 2006 Fox Sports plans to continue with periodic broadcasts of dart events.

The Professional Dart Corporation (PDC), the British corporation running the big professional tournaments in England and the Las Vegas Desert Classic, is crossing the Pond again with a World Series of Darts in Connecticut on May 19-21. Top prize is \$100,000, or \$1,000, 000 if the winner is American. Seeing that not one American is rated in the top 100...well, it looks like a long shot for an American taking home the million. This tournament will be on either Fox Sports or ESPN. ◀◀
